Mayors, Takes Top Honors in Best Talk Show Category at 19th Annual Star Awards*

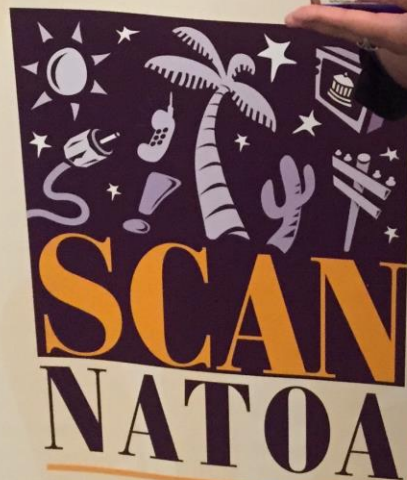
